ENTRY FORM

FILLMORE COUNTY FAIR DEMOLITION DERBY

JULY 25, 2009

START TIME: 7:00 PM

In the interest of safety, everyone is subject and must obey the following rules and regulations, which are set up by the Fillmore Agriculture Society and Preston Firefighters Activity Association.

- A. Each driver **MUST** fill out an entry blank.
- B. Officials reserve the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
- C. Only the driver, owner, mechanics, etc. who sign the release form will be permitted in the pit area.

DRIVERS ENTRY

1. Anyone with a valid driver's license may participate in the derby. Any driver seen deliberately hitting the driver's door of another car will be disqualified. **DERBY OFFICIALS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.** No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pits. **NOTICE:** All persons under the age of 18 years of age **MUST HAVE A MINOR RELEASE WAIVER SIGNED BY A PARENT AND NOTARIZED.** Waiver release is located at the bottom of the entry form.
2. One entry per person. Any driver not obeying the rules will be disqualified. For the safety of all concerned, this will be enforced.

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS

1. Regular passenger cars, station wagons are allowed. Station wagons **MUST** remove rear deck lid. **NO CONVERTIBLES, NO IMPERIALS, NO PICKUPS, TRUCKS, HEARSEs, FOUR-WHEEL DRIVES or AMBULANCES ALLOWED.** Cars must have a bumper height of **NOT** more than 28 inches. All cars will be inspected before derby. **CARS NOT PASSING INSPECTION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE AND WILL FORFEIT ALL ENTRY FEE MONEY INCLUDING PIT CREW ENTRY FEES.**
2. Front doors must be clean for numbering. For easier identification , upright tin on roof for number board (for scoring purposes)
- *3. No profanity or obscene objects on cars. (this is a family event)
4. Safety belts and helmets are mandatory while on track.
- 5A. A Maximum of 5 gallons of gas will be allowed. Gas tanks are to be moved to the rear seat area and securely fastened and covered. **NO PLASTIC GAS TANKS ALLOWED, METAL ONLY.** Original gas tank must be removed. Battery must be moved to the inside of the car, securely fastened and covered. No bungee cords allowed.
- 5B. Electric fuel pumps **must be toggle switched** and easily accessible.
6. All glass including head and taillights and windshield must be removed.
- 7A. **BUMPERS:** No special bumpers **or** any reinforcements will be allowed. No trailer hitches, bumper brackets or shocks may be welded or chained to frame. No adding metal.
- 7B. **FRAMES:** No plating, welding or reinforcing in any way.

7C. **BODY MOUNTS:** May be modified. No extra non-factory mounts. Plates no larger than 4"x 4".

8. Driver's door may be reinforced. Also door-to-door brace behind driver's seat (post to post one beam)

*9. All doors must be fastened shut with wire straps, chains or **welded (vertical door seams only)**. **Up to a 3" wide vertical strap maybe welded to the vertical door seams.** Hood and trunk can be tied or chained down after inspection, **cannot** be welded down. The hood can have 4 bolts or chains and the trunk can have 2 bolts or chains. Plates no larger than 4"x 4". **NO** angle iron hold downs.

10. All cars must be removed from fairgrounds by 12:01 am July 26, 2009 or Fillmore County Ag Society will assume the vehicle.

11. No spring jacks or blocked shocks. Suspension must be free of blocks. Coil springs may be welded in.

12. Cutting fender for original wheel clearance only is permissible.

13. Boundaries must be observed. All 4 wheels out of boundaries are automatically disqualified.

14. Vehicles must have brakes before beginning of heat.

15. **NO** alcoholic beverages allowed in pit area or on track. If alcohol is found, automatic disqualification with no refunds.

16. All cars will be inspected before the race. Winning cars will be inspected again after 15-minute work period.

17. **NOTICE TO ALL FEATURE QUALIFIERS AND CONSOLATION WINNERS:** There will be an area set up in the pit area for feature qualifiers. This means that your car will be in an area after the heat and guarded. No one will work on their car until the consolation heat is over. At this time, the consolation and heat qualifiers will have 15 minutes to prepare the cars for the feature.

18. No junk tires, wheels, metal parts, etc. will be allowed in the car. Cars must be clean.

19. No cutting torches or welders will be allowed in the pit area. Electric or air tools only. **NO OPEN FLAMES.**

20. No water tanks for cooling.

21. Radiators must be in stock and in original mounts.

22. All tires must be air tires. No solid tires, airplane tires, tractor, implement, skid loader tires or rough tread tires permitted. No more than 6-ply, 70 series, max 35 psi, passenger car tires. Stock type wheels only. Stem protectors allowed. No tire liners or putting one tire inside of another allowed, **all wheel weights must be removed.**

23. All cars must be in the pits 1 hour before start time for inspection. Mandatory pit meeting 1/2 hour before start time.

24. No skid loader, backhoes or heavy equipment in the pits.

COMPACT CLASS

1. 4 and 6 cylinder only.

2. Wheelbase – 105" or less.

3. Door bars **highly** recommended.

4. **All other rules still apply.**

5. One heat only. **NO ADVANCEMENT.**

6. Stock bumpers only. No full size bumpers.

SPECIAL RULES OF OPERATION

No deliberate head on crashes. No intentional hitting driver side door. Keep speed down, this is not an auto race. All cars must run in heat to be eligible for the feature. Two winners of each heat are eligible for the feature. A time limit of 1 minute is established in which all cars must make solid contact with another car under its own power. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. You will be timed.

***NOTES THE CHANGES FOR 2009**

DEMO DERBY HEATS AND FEATURE

The feature event will be the first two cars in each heat. Trophy and prize money to winner and runner-up of feature event. Trophy and prize money to two winners of each heat and winner of consolation.

Payback:

- 2 winners from each Heat - \$100.00 ea (Up to 4 Heats depending on number of entries)
- 1 winner from Consolation - \$100.00
- 2 winners from Compact – 1st place - \$100.00
2nd place - \$50.00
- 2 winners from Feature – 1st place - \$300.00
2nd place - \$200.00
